## **NOBIS GROUP STEM SCHOLARSHIP**

Nobis Group (Nobis) is proud to offer scholarships to high school graduating seniors who have demonstrated an interest in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics (STEM) career such as environmental studies, civil engineering, geotechnical engineering, hydrogeology, chemical engineering, health sciences, etc. Applicants must be a United States citizen and current resident of New Hampshire or Massachusetts. *Nobis employees, or spouses or children of Nobis employees are not eligible.*

Scholarship selection will be based upon demonstrated interest, weighted Grade Point Average (GPA) or class rank, and essay. The recipient must have been accepted by a post-secondary school. This one time, non-renewable scholarship will be awarded to one or more students in the amount of \$500 each.

To be considered, students must submit their completed application, essay, and transcript to **[scholarship@nobis-group.com](mailto:scholarship@nobis-group.com)** by **March 31, 2020**.

Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than **May 1, 2020**. Scholarship checks will be made payable directly to the chosen school.
