



2023 NOBIS GROUP STEM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Nobis Group (Nobis) is proud to offer scholarships to high school graduating seniors who have demonstrated an interest in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics (STEM) career. Applicants must be a United States citizen and current resident of New Hampshire or Massachusetts. Nobis employees, or spouses or children of Nobis employees are not eligible. Scholarship selection will be based upon demonstrated interest, weighted Grade Point Average (GPA) or class rank, and essay. The recipient must have been accepted by a post-secondary school. This one time, non-renewable scholarship will be awarded to one or more students in the amount of \$750 each.

To be considered, students must submit their completed application, essay, and transcript to **scholarship@nobis-group.com** by **April 30, 2023**.

Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than **May 26, 2023**. Scholarship checks will be made payable directly to the chosen school.

ELIGIBILITY

- This application may be completed by any student, but only those students that have been accepted by an institution of higher learning by the time of selection will be eligible for the scholarship.
- The recipient must be a full-time student.
- The graduating senior must have a demonstrated interest in Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics (STEM) and **must be pursuing a degree in one of the following fields:** civil, geotechnical, or environmental engineering; environmental science; geology/hydrogeology; or construction management.
